## WAYS TO GIVE:

### OUTRIGHT GIFT

The simplest way to participate is to make a gift during your lifetime. There may be tax advantages for such gifts. Some examples are cash, securities, annuities and real property.

### BEQUEST BY WILL

You might consider including **The Endowment Fund of Fairmount Community Church UCC** in your will. Such a bequest may have important tax benefits for you.

### LIFE INSURANCE

**The Endowment Fund of Fairmount Community Church UCC** can be named the beneficiary of your policy. The premium you pay may be a tax advantage. There may also be other tax advantages for you.

### CREATION OF A TRUST

Trusts, either living or under a will, can be written to cover many situations. They can provide for your financial needs, those of designated others, and eventually pay the principal or income to **The Endowment Fund of Fairmount Community Church UCC**.

### LIFE INCOME GIFTS

These provide income for you or designated others during your lifetime. Upon your death, ownership of the gift goes to **The Endowment Fund of Fairmount Community Church UCC**.
